1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:

Apologies were tendered and approved for Cllr Lyons (unwell). No apologies were received from Cllr English and Cllr Donovan

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST:

3. 2019/20 PRECEPT:

Members discussed the budget and precept report presented by the RFO/Clerk.

It was noted that there wasn't a project for this coming year.

Main headlines for 2019/20 from the report:

1. Reduction in litter picking budget due to a decrease in litter picker but some monies for additional picks

- 2. Recommendation to withdraw from CDALC with an annual saving of over £300
- 3. A 2% pay raise for Clerk (first increase since 2014)
- 4. Removal of room hire costs from subsequent budgets

5. Grass cutting costs remain as 2018. Reduction this year was only 12 carried out (budget is for 14)

Members were disappointed that no litter picker for Evenwood village had be found but noted that some contingency was placed in the budget.

The recommendation to withdraw from the County Durham Association of Local Councils was considered. Members felt that no tangible benefit to being in the Association could be seen. **RESOLVED:** It was proposed by Cllr Spraggon and seconded by Cllr Sewell that Evenwood & Barony Council withdraw from CDALC. **Action:** Clerk will inform CDALC

The grass cutting budget remains as 2018/19 but tenders for the 2019 season will be considered.
