Chair's Report

Read through any of our minutes over the last year and the dialogue would be more or less the same; Dog Fouling, Welfare Ground Issues, Cemetery, replacement bollards and countless repairs. These issues come before us time and time again. So what were the Parish Council issues of many years ago;

1953 - Residents at The Centre Evenwood received a letter asking them to remove a clothes post from the Village Green, as it was not allowed. Permission was given to allow a Telephone Kiosk to be sited on the Village Green, near the Central Stores. 700 Coronation Mugs were purchased for all children, within the Barony, up to the age of 15. Any child born on Coronation Day would also received a silver spoon. Total Costs, £68. 5s. 0d. (£68.25p) Wonder if anyone has a silver spoon?

1893 - Inspectors had cause to visit a house in Evenwood due to unsanitary findings. Shows and shooting galleries will not be allowed onto Village Green as they are deemed to be dangerous. Local police to keep watch.

1973 -The only issue of importance of 50 years ago was the demolition of the Old Man's Hut at Bank Top. A fond memory to those of a certain age. As stated last year, the PACT meetings re-commenced. In one year we have seen three PCSO's come and go. How can they be expected to engage with the Community if they move on so quickly? The next PACT meeting needs to be full to capacity and the press should be in attendance and report on local issues. Attend your PACT Meetings, have your say or just listen, but make up the numbers. Don't give the Police a reason to stop the meetings.

At our last AGM we were visited by Joy Allen, the new Police & Crime Commissioner, who gave a good talk, handed out her brochures and promised to deliver her manifesto. She emphasised that the elderly and those who live alone to report any crime by phoning it in to the local police station. With all the will in the world, has anyone tried to get through to 101, especially if you are vulnerable and need support straight away. Dog fouling is a growing concern, which is regularly discussed at our meetings. The Street Warden will only get involved if it can be witnessed, or you can name the culprit, or even better if you can take a photo of the deed being done.

We do have some positives, the Emergency Initiative Plan has been produced. Our thanks go to those who worked on this for their respective parish wards A vast amount of information put together, with guidance for all. A Lights Committee who are striving to light up Evenwood & Ramshaw hope to make a start by this Christmas. They have been meeting over the last few months and we hope to get some updates to see how they are progressing. We fully support this initiative and will help if we can.

We are also interested in hearing from the Evenwood in Bloom members. Their displays in the summer months have been noted. We would suggest they get in touch, we may be able to assist.

We had two resignations since our last AGM, however two new members have joined the Parish Council and have been made very welcome.

A project to renovate the site of the Bank Top bus shelter is in discussion.

As always, thank you to all who have sat around many meetings, often discussing the good, the bad and sometimes the unprintable. It is what we expect, however it is not deserved.

To our Clerk, Sharon who has had to tackle many issues and keep the peace. (I did warn her) many thanks for your patience.
